## COVID-19 Visitation Guidelines

As we anticipate opening visitation to parents/guardians, Rite of Passage will continue to follow CDC and State guidelines to ensure the safety and wellbeing of its student athletes, staff and visitors. The following steps will be implemented to ensure visitation practices are in line with CDC and State guidelines:

- Screening of all parent(s)/legal guardian(s) will continue by using the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) screening form. Temperature of parent(s)/legal guardian(s) will be taken prior to and upon commencement of visitation. Temperatures will be recorded on the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) screening form. Parents/legal guardian will be notified of the criteria when scheduling the visitation time.
- The program staff, student athletes and visitors will continue to practice social distancing. This will limit physical interactions between youth and their parent(s)/legal guardian(s).
- All visitors will be encouraged to bring their own mask to utilize during visitation. If the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) does not have access to a mask, the program, when possible, will provide a mask for the parent(s)/legal guardian(s). (Notice to parent(s)/legal guardian(s) regarding mask requirement will be done when each visitation is scheduled.)
- Visitation is limited to parent(s)/legal guardian(s) only. Only two visitors per youth at a time. (Visitation time slots will not exceed 10 individuals three (3) student athletes, Two (2) visitors per student athlete, one (1) staff)
- Pre-determined time slots will be held on Saturday and Sunday unless otherwise pre-determined and approved by the Program Director.
- Therapeutic Managers will contact parent(s)/legal guardian(s) at least seven (7) days prior to schedule visitation time slots. Parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must reserve a visitation time slot as open visitations are prohibited at this time.
  - Time-Slots: Sat/Sun 9:00am to 11:00am, 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm, & 3:15pm to 5:15pm (Student Athlete Group schedules may need to be adjusted pending scheduled visitation time slot)
- Facility cleaning and sanitation will be conducted prior to and immediately following each visitation time slot.
- During this visitation process no gifts or “care packages” for youth will be allowed.
- We will encourage the elderly population to understand the risk of entering the facility.
- We will not allow visitation if we have a positive or pending COVID-19 test.
- If visitation is scheduled and the program has a test result pending the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must be notified as soon as possible that the visit has been cancelled.
